



We use **capital letters** at the **beginning** of a sentence.

2. Hint

We always write I with a capital letter.

We don't use capital letters in the **middle** of a word.

Which sentences have capital letters in the correct places?

Answer key: A, B

These sentences have capital letters in the correct places:

- I am six.
- Tom is ten.

These sentences *do not* have capital letters in the correct places:

- i Got uP. This should be: I got up.
- hE got His bag. This should be: **H**e got his bag.
