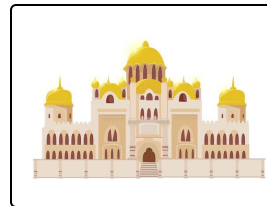
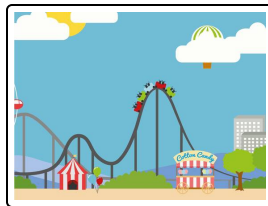
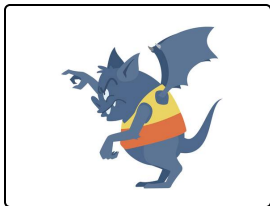

Decide if it is a character or a setting.

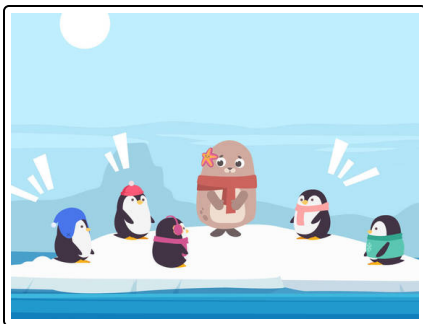
1. Hint

A character is a person, animal, creature, or thing that plays an important part in a story.

2. Hint

A setting is a *place* where a story happens.

Here we can see the **setting** is the iceberg and the **characters** are the penguins.

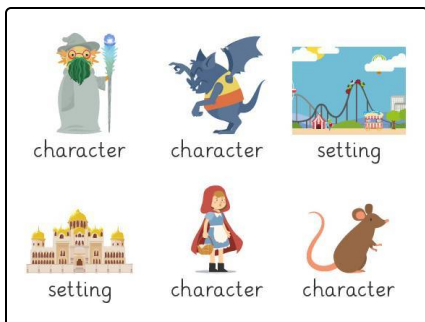


Solutions and solution approaches for the tasks
